Dr. Loretta Ford, co-founder of the Nurse Practitioner profession.

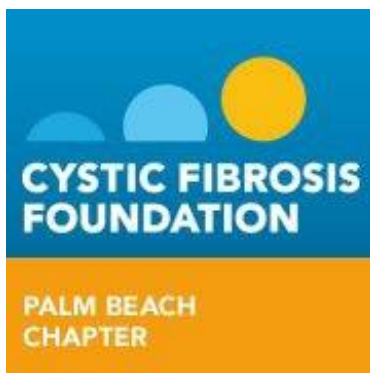
Popular guest moderator will be **Dr. Christopher Saslo**, DNS, FAANP, ARNP-BC.
