## Hepatitis B Standing Orders

The Florida Department of Health has been working to get Palm Beach County hospitals to administer Hepatitis B at birth prior to discharge. We are one of the few counties in Florida who have ANY hospitals remaining who do not have standing Hep B orders. In January of 2015 only TWO hospitals were administering Hep B in our county. Now we are up to FOUR with two more coming on board in the next few months! We need all of your help to support this important program!

### **BABCOCK, Dr. Stuart A.**

**1938-2015**

Dr. Stuart Babcock passed away at Palm Beach Gardens Medical Center on Monday, December 14, 2015. Dr Babcock began his 45 years' career as a Pediatrician in 1964. He was one of the first Neonatologist to practice in Palm Beach County and has been credited with saving literally hundreds if not thousands of lives of newborn babies and children.

Henry John Richmond MD, 92, passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, October 27, 2015, surrounded by his family. Jack, as he was affectionately known, had been a pediatrician in Lake Worth for over 40 years.
